



## TERMS AND CONDITIONS Ministry of Kids Club (MOK)

### Public Liability Insurance/DBS checks

Your children whilst in our care are covered by the insurance of Ministry of Kids (MOK). All adults assisting in MOK have been DBS checked and have attended First Aid training.

### Cost & Payment

Full day sessions at Shifnal Scout Hut are 9.30 – 5.00pm @ £29.00 per day  
Extended day sessions at Shifnal Scout Hut are from 8.00 – 5.30pm @ £32.00 per day  
Trip day sessions are from 8.45 – 5pm @ £33.00 per day

**Full payment needs to be received within 7 days before attending MOK and a 50% non-refundable amount will be kept if my child does not attend due to illness or non-attendance. Your child's place is not confirmed until payment has been received.**

### Food & Drink

Please send your child with a water/juice bottle to keep them hydrated throughout the day. Extra drinks will be provided. Break times in morning and afternoon will include a snack and drink.
